This international sculptor originally from Watford, successfully blends ancient with modern and has been praised for his understanding and exploitation of the stone with which he works.

All of these artists share the influence of nature on their work and the Limberhurst Art Centre will provide an apt setting for the pieces.

Opening on Saturday, July 4th, the exhibition runs until the end of August and will include the works of more than 30 sculptors, making it one of the largest exhibitions in Cambridgeshire open to the public.
