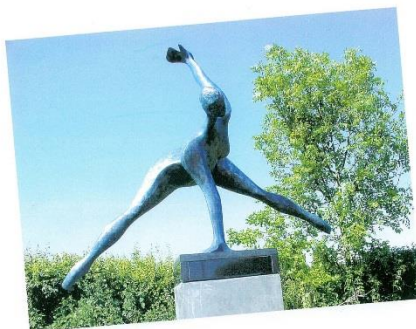

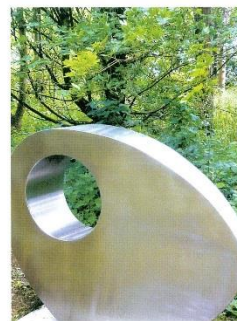
Limberhurst Art Centre will be alive with sculpture this summer, when more than 30 local, national and international sculptors exhibit their work. Jessica Ablitt Sudbury takes a closer look at the artwork on show

What could be better than a leisurely amble around 13 acres of beautiful Cambridgeshire countryside? Well, maybe if those 13 acres were filled with some of the finest sculptures from UK and international artists, including members of the Royal British Society of Sculptors. Look no further than Art Contact's Summer Sculpture exhibition at Limberhurst Art Centre sculpture garden at Horseheath, Cambridge.

To celebrate its 25th anniversary, art consultancy Art Contact, has put together an eclectic mix of stunning pieces by renowned sculptors, including Colin Rose, Dorothy Brook, Simon Hitchen, Lucy Unwin and Nicolas Moreton.

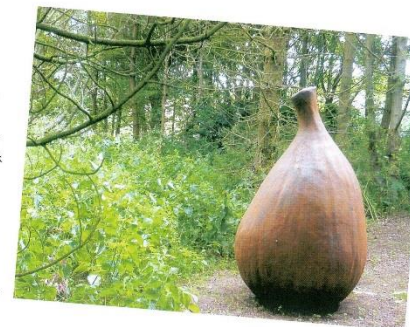
British-born Colin Rose's work is perfect for this countryside exhibition, as he

often sculpts large-scale metal or wooden structures that are placed in trees. He creates pieces that are in harmony with nature and sometimes his work completes the structure of a tree that has perhaps lost a branch or sustained damage in the past.



Contrastingly, London-trained sculptor Dorothy Brook is inspired by the shape and movement of the human body. You can find her statuesque Raindance and Equilibrium pieces drawing crowds to the Limberhurst Art Centre garden this summer.

Lucy Unwin, born in Bury St Edmunds, is also enthused by organic shapes found in both nature and the human body. Her impressive The Three Graces, which will be in the exhibition, is made from welded steel bars of different lengths and thicknesses. Lucy enjoys the physical and mental processes of constructing the steel pieces and her artwork captures the movement of the human form in a striking way.



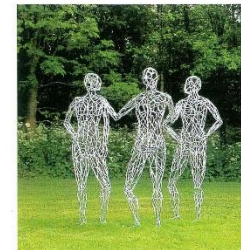

You can also see Nicolas Moreton's majestic hand-carved Sunrise. This international sculptor originally from Watford, successfully blends ancient with modern and has been praised for his understanding and exploitation of the stone with which he works.

All of these artists share the influence of nature on their work and the Limberhurst Art Centre will provide an apt setting for the pieces.

Opening on Saturday, July 4th, the exhibition runs until the end of August and will include the works of more than 30 sculptors, making it one of the largest exhibitions in Cambridgeshire open to the public. There will also be works by photographer Stuart Reddie displayed in the interior gallery at the Art Centre.
